Alliance College-Ready Public Schools operates 14 high schools and 6 middle schools in neighborhoods all over Los Angeles and will be opening new schools in the 2012-13 academic year. Alliance is a top-performing charter school organization; in 2011, three of our high schools ranked in the top 10 of all Los Angeles Unified School District high schools. Four Alliance schools are California Distinguished Schools and one is a National Blue Ribbon School.

We are proud that Alliance public schools rank among the highest performing schools in LAUSD. These strong results confirm our belief that all students can achieve at high levels and be ready for success in college. We look forward to continued academic success in the new school year.

Alliance delivers on its college-ready promise by offering rigorous college-prep A-G coursework in an educational model based on our five core values: high expectations for all students, small personalized schools and classrooms, increased instructional time, highly effective principals and teachers, and working with parents as partners.

We are particularly proud of the fact that 96% of Alliance graduating seniors were accepted to four-year universities/colleges last year including such world-class institutions as Princeton, Vassar, Stanford, and the University of California, Berkeley. In total, Alliance graduates enrolled at more than 67 colleges in California and 23 other states last year. This can happen for your child, too.

La Alianza de Escuelas Públicas Preparatorias dirige 14 escuelas preparatorias (high school) y 6 escuelas intermedias (middle school) en las comunidades de Los Angeles e inaugurará más escuelas durante el año académico 2012-13. La Alianza es una organización de escuelas de alto-rendimiento; en el 2011, tres de nuestras escuelas preparatorias fueron clasificadas dentro de las 10 mejores del Distrito Escolar Unificado de Los Angeles (LAUSD). Cuatro escuelas de la Alianza son Escuelas Distinguidas de California (California Distinguished Schools) y una es una Escuela de Liston Azul de la Nación (National Blue Ribbon School).

Estamos orgullosos de que nuestras escuelas autónomas están clasificadas entre las mejores escuelas de LAUSD. TRACK RECORD OF SUCCESS

Alliance has demonstrated a proven track record of success. For school year 2010-11:

- Four Alliance schools are beyond the 800 API state target
- 87% of Alliance 10th graders passed the California High School Exit Exam on the first attempt
- Increased the number of students taking Advanced Placement Exams and the number achieving a score of 3 or higher, earning students college credit
- 98% of Alliance students graduated in four years
- 96% of students were admitted into a 4-year college
- 22% English Learners redesignation rate to Fluent English
